## Scholarship Application Eligibility

-Full-time undergraduate students who have completed at least 24 academic credits at the time of participation.
-Requires financial assistance in order to participate
-2.75 minimum GPA

-Must have completed 2 out of 4 application forms with Lynn University's Center for Learning Abroad

-Must meet with the Center for Learning Abroad to discuss courses prior to applying

-Must apply by the application deadline

-Upon notification of acceptance, the recipient will be required to write an acknowledgement letter to Ms. Wold

## Important Information Regarding Finances

-The scholarship will cover your ACD tuition costs, but you will be responsible for Room and Board + Fees -You will not be able to take any additional Lynn institutional aid beyond what is covered by this scholarship

-You are able to take classes online at Lynn while at ACD, but you will be responsible for the cost of tuition for those courses

-If you apply for the Spring semester, this scholarship will not cover your J-term tuition at Lynn
