Eligibility

Student grant applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- 2.75 minimum GPA
- Must be accepted into a Lynn-approved CIEE spring semester program

How to apply

Student grant applicants must complete and submit the following by the application deadline:

- CLA study abroad application forms (complete online)
- CIEE student grant application (this form)

Application deadline: **OCTOBER 2, 2017**

All application materials listed above must be submitted to the Center for Learning Abroad (CLA) by 5:00 pm on October 2, 2017. The study abroad application forms are to be completed online through the CLA website (<https://lynn.abroadoffice.net>). The student grant application may be submitted in person or via email (cla@lynn.edu). The CLA is located in the Lynn Student Center (outside the Dining Commons).
