Eligibility

Student grant applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Full-time, undergraduate student with at least 15 credits
- 2.75 minimum GPA
- Must be accepted into a Lynn-approved CIEE Open Campus program

How to apply

Student grant applicants must complete and submit the following by the application deadline:

- CLA study abroad application forms (complete online). Students should apply to the CIEE Open Campus program that is his/her first choice.
- CIEE student grant application (this form)

Application deadline: SEPTEMBER 28, 2017

All application materials listed above must be submitted to the Center for Learning Abroad (CLA) by 5:00 pm on September 28, 2017. The study abroad application forms are to be completed online through the CLA website (https://lynn.abroadoffice.net). The student grant application may be submitted in person or via email (cla@lynn.edu). The CLA is located in the Lynn Student Center (outside the Dining Commons). Late and/or incomplete applications will not be considered.
