Scholarship and amounts

Designed to support students pursuing business-related majors, the scholarship provides funding to deserving individuals to offset the cost for a study abroad program. The number of scholarships and the amount are determined annually and depend on income generated by the endowment.

For the 2019 spring semester, two (2) scholarships in the amount of \$2,500 will be awarded.

Scholarship eligibility

- Full-time, undergraduate student with at least 24 credits
- Student pursuing a major in the College of Business and Management
- Student with demonstrated financial need
- 2.75 minimum GPA
- Must be accepted into a Lynn-approved, business-focused study abroad program

How to apply

Scholarship applicants must complete and submit the following by the application deadline:

- CLA study abroad application forms (complete online)
- Lynn University Boice Scholarship application and essay (this form)

Application deadline: OCTOBER 1

All application materials listed above must be submitted to the Center for Learning Abroad (CLA) by 5:00 pm on October 1. The study abroad application forms are to be completed online through the CLA website <https://lynn.abroadoffice.net>. The scholarship application and essay may be submitted in person or via email to cla@lynn.edu. The CLA is located in the Lynn Student Center outside the Dining Commons.

Late and/or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Scholarship recipient requirements

Upon notification that he/she has been selected, the recipient will be required to write an Acknowledgment Letter addressed to Ms. Yvonne Boice, whose generosity and support of Lynn University led to the creation of the scholarship.
