



Overview

Located in Costa Rica, within the United Nations-mandated University for Peace (UPEACE), the UPEACE Centre for Executive Education delivers dynamic courses to leaders from around the world. Specifically designed for educators, the 3-day workshop, “Global Education: Cultivating innovation in the classroom,” covers topic areas such as education in a changing world, design thinking, global citizenship and storytelling. Each summer, the CLA and the Office for Academic Affairs provide funding for Lynn faculty to participate on faculty development opportunities including the Global Education workshop at UPEACE in Costa Rica. Funding for round-trip airfare is also provided. Applications for the workshop are competitive.

Eligibility

Faculty grant applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements:

- Full-time faculty
- Must demonstrate the relevance of the workshop to the faculty’s academic discipline
- Applicants cannot have received faculty development funding for the previous two summers
