

Scholarship and amounts

A long-standing supporter of Lynn University, Elaine Johnson Wold has generously provided scholarship funds to cover the cost of tuition at American College Dublin for eligible and qualified students who choose to attend during a fall, spring, or summer term. Up to three scholarships are available each term.

This scholarship form is to be used by any student applying to ACD during any term – fall, spring, or summer.

Scholarship eligibility

- Full-time, undergraduate student with at least 24 credits
- Student with demonstrated financial need
- 2.75 minimum GPA
- Must have completed 2 out of 4 application forms with the Lynn University CLA
- Must meet with the Center for Learning Abroad to discuss courses prior to applying

Important financial information

- The scholarship will cover your ACD tuition costs, but you will be responsible for Room and Board + Fees
- You will not be able to take any additional Lynn institutional aid beyond what is covered by this scholarship
- You are able to take classes online at Lynn while at ACD, but you will be responsible for the cost of tuition for those courses
- If you apply for the Spring semester, this scholarship will not cover your J-term tuition at Lynn

How to apply

Scholarship applicants must complete and submit the following by the application deadline:

- CLA study abroad application forms for ACD (complete online)
- Elaine Johnson Wold American College Dublin Scholarship application and essay (this form)

Application deadline:

- For students planning to study abroad in the fall: **MARCH 1**
- For students planning to study abroad in the summer: **MARCH 1**
- For students planning to study abroad in the spring: **SEPTEMBER 15**

All application materials listed above must be submitted to the Center for Learning Abroad (CLA) by 5:00 pm on deadline noted above. The scholarship application and essay may be submitted in person or via email to cla@lynn.edu.

Late and/or incomplete applications will not be considered.

Scholarship recipient requirements

Upon notification that he/she has been selected, the recipient will be required to write an Acknowledgment Letter addressed to Ms. Elaine Johnson Wold, whose generosity and support of Lynn University led to the creation of the scholarship.
